2014. Nov - Dec **UBS Swiss Bank, Internal project. Drupal Developer. (Switzerland).**

Development of the employee's internal assistance website. This project was for two months and finished in one and a half.

- Drupal 7
- Theme based on Bootstrap 3. Design provided by the client.
- Standard 3rd party modules: The usual ones: Views, Crumbs, Quicktabs, Entity, i18n, Calendar.
- Custom implementation of Booking Timeslots, to make a booking system for the Store.
- Custom module for sending iCal invites and appointments (with updates) when a booking happens.
- It was implemented with Panels but later we decide to use Context and some custom templates to simplify the structure.
- Code control with SVN. Use of Docker for virtualization. Use of JIRA for issues

2014. Jan – Nov **Everis Barcelona – Drupal team leader. (Spain, Brussels).**

Leading a team of four developers in projects for the European Commission. Most notable ones: Eltis and DevCo EuropeAid.

Visiting clients in Brussels to get info about the projects, analyzing the requirements, making the schedules and leading the team for implementation. We strictly followed the Drupal Standards as everything had to pass the Quality Assurance of the Commission.

I was also teaching Drupal to the Junior team members.

It was developed along 4 months. Half month for analysis, 2 and a half months for implementations, 1 month more for issues.

- Based on Bootstrap 3 for the theming.
- Standard 3rd party modules: Views, Features, jQuery, Varnish, i18n, Apache Solr. Feeds for content migration from a previous site. Print PDF with custom templates. Context, Custom Breadcrumbs, Quicktabs. Advanced Forum.
- Custom modules for fine tuning Solr searches.

Development and Cooperation – EuropeAid.

This was developed during 5 months. A continuous integration as the site was launched and the development of new parts has to begin.

- Implementation of the Drupal 7 based distribution from the European Commission: Multisite
- Specific subtheme, bootstrap based.
- In this case, we have to use most of the features provided by the EC Profile, but also we generated new ones as Custom Mappings, Custom modules for search, Custom menu, Print PDF, etc.
- It makes an intense use of Feeds for content retrieval from other sources/sites.

In these two big projects at Everis we used Jira and Atlassian tools to track issues and for sprints.

The code control was with GIT and SVN.

Drupal site for the Bank of Santander. Design provided by the client. I have developed the backend and adapted the designs for the frontend.

Typical 3rd party modules. Also, custom implementations to connect to the internal authentication system of the Bank.

Highly customized Drupal site. The design was also provided by the client.

The most complicated part was to create a custom module for the comparison of the different insurance options.

3rd party modules: Feeds for content migration. Context, Pathauto, Views, Boost for caching, Facetapi for searches (Solr couldn't be used), Entity and Entity Reference, Ctools for custom ajax responders, FB Oauth, Flexslider, i18n, jCarousel, jPlayer, Integration with MailChimp for newsletters, Multifield, Nodequeue, Rules, Quicktabs, Megamenu, Token, Voting API, Variable. Custom module for Quizzes and Contests. A very simple one.

2011 – 2012. **Many different sites, almost all of them very easy to implement. Also I took a break of 8 months for a personal project.**

The usual modules that I use in every Drupal installation are:

For structure: Views, Context. Sometime I use Panels but I prefer (depending on the case) to use Context + Custom templates. Crumbs, Menu attributes, Pathauto, Transliteration, References, WYSIWYG, Token.

For theming: Normally based on a well-known framework as Bootstrap or Omega. Also with help from modules FontYourFace, Colorbox, some kind of Slider (i.e.: Flexslider), TB Megamenu. I have used many more, but these are the essential in all the projects.

Some more projects, all in Drupal:

For performance: Varnish (if the server allows it), Boost, Memcache.

This site is a Drupal very customized and optimized. It's a Tourism site for a private company that handles more than 150.000 images and 40.000 nodes.

It was used Node Import module to import all the data from a Filemaker Database to the Drupal.

It uses the typical 3rd party modules, as Views, Pathauto, Location + GMaps, Context, Boost, Flag, Geocode, i18n, Lightbox, Nodequeue, SMTP + PHPMailer, Quicktabs, Rules, Token, Varnish, Webform, etc.

It also implements custom modules for category paths, as the structure mixing two taxonomies was not possible to automatize.

It has custom modules for the Coupon System, to generate and send PDF coupons to the user's mail.

It has custom module to route planning between nodes.

It has an implementation of Paypal Payments.

It has a custom module for a Dashboard for clients.

It is by far the most complex project.

It's an on-going project that we're always improving.
